Glenn Arbour Academy is pleased to provide a bus program for the 2017-2018 school year. The bus service will be provided by Attridge Transportation of Burlington. The bus program offers door to door morning and after school service. The bus program gives the students an opportunity to spend time with their fellow students, complete their homework or enjoy a quiet time to themselves before or after a busy school day.

The bus route will be covering the area, in the West to Brant Street- North to Dundas including a portion of Cedar Springs Road and East to Neyagawa in Oakville. Please note, this year we are offering only one-way service to Burlington in the morning, and one-way service to Oakville in the afternoon. If your home falls outside the mentioned area and you are interested in bus service please call either Mrs. MacKinnon or Mrs. Harris at the school.

We will work with the bus provider to ensure that the route is efficient as possible, providing the shortest ride time possible for each student.

Please note: This year we will not be providing **unscheduled** rides.

SCHOOL BUS PROTOCOL:

- **Respect.** Children are to be respectful at all times and listen to the driver's instructions.
- **Punctuality.** It is extremely important to be ready on time for the bus, waiting outside, as there are a number of pick-ups and we would like our children to arrive on time to school.
- **Snacks.** No eating or drinking on the bus.
- **Lost Items.** Lost or stolen items are not the responsibility of the school or bus company.
- **Absence.** If for any reason your child will not be attending school or plans to sleep over and go home with another child please inform the school as soon as you know.
- **Snow Day.** The school bus will follow the snow days of the Halton District School Board. If there is no snow day but there is inclement weather en route or in Burlington, the driver will notify parents prior to 6:45 am as to whether the bus will be operational.
- **Responsibility.** Arrange to have a responsible person at your home after school to receive the student. In the case of unforeseen circumstances, please contact our school bus coordinator as early as possible to coordinate alternate arrangements.
